Wilson Fruitless Olive

'Wilsonii'™ olive is a Mediterranean native seemingly tailor-made for California landscapes where water is precious and heat is expected. This evergreen olive is not like other 'Wilsonii' varieties in the industry and is distinguished by its very low fruiting custom. Topping out at about 25 feet tall and wide, it has a lovely open form that appeals to landscape architects and contractors seeking a less densely foliated olive. As with all olives, the gray/green narrow leaves and bumpy trunk offers fantastic character and individuality to each specimen. Olea europaea 'Wilsonii'™ enjoys full sun, low water, and placement in Sunset Garden zones 8, 9, 11-24, H1 and H2. -Boething Treeland Nursery

Pride Of Madeira

Mature specimens of this evergreen shrub can grow to a size of 6'-8' tall and 8'-10' wide. In the spring, spikes of bluepurple flowers appear above the gray green foliage. It should receive full sun in coastal areas. In warmer inland areas, it should get some afternoon shade and more water during summer. However, once it's established, it needs little or no summer watering. This plant can be severely damaged by frost below 25 degrees F. Prune during fall to encourage lower branches to bloom. Great shrub for hillsides where it can spread. Honey bees love this plant. Does great in poor, dry soil. All parts of plant are poisonous.

A dwarf, compact evergreen shrub with small, dark green leaves, this plant is an example of an excellent dwarf hedge or foundation shrub. It slowly reaches 2' tall and 1' wide, perhaps taking 10 years to reach this size. It does best with full to part sun and regular watering and more during hot summer months. It tolerates heat, coastal conditions and poor soil. This is a great plant for topiaries and containers. Flowers are inconspicuous.

Plant in full to part sun and water regularly, more during hot days. White flowers bloom in the spring but this plant is primarily grown for the foliage. Give afternoon shade in warm inland valleys. Great plant near the swimming pool and in coastal areas.



Woolly Blue Curls

Woolly Blue Curls is an evergreen shrub that reaches 3'-5' high. It has an open branching habit and has long stalks of brilliant purple woolly flowers in the spring and summer. This California native, is drought tolerant, and attracts hummingbirds. It puts on a dramatic display of purple stealing the show when in bloom. This is a highly prized compact, medium sized shrub that produces breath-taking deep purple to blue flowers. This shrub prefers minimal watering after establishment, well drained soil and plenty of sun. It naturally occurs below 2000' ft. Woolly Blue Curls grows fast, reaching about 4 ft in height and the same in width. The leaves are needle like, thick skinned points that are a light to dark green. The spring and summer flowers are loved by bees, hummingbirds, butterflies, and a favorite of Native gardeners. This very hardy, drought tolerant native was extremely important to indigenous Americans, who used almost all parts of the plant for medicinal uses, especially for stomach ailments. Indeed, it became so important that it was used as a currency at times. Tea made from sprigs of Woolly Blue Curls is also extremely tasty, with a soothing, calming effect.

It prefers full to part sun and becomes drought tolerant once it's established. Following bloom, one should dead head the plant and divide the clumps when it appears crowded to keep it looking tidy.

Star Jasmine is an evergreen vine/shrub/ground cover that grows 20' tall or a ground cover that reaches 1'-2' tall and 4'-5' wide. It has white fragrant flowers in the summer and can tolerate sun or partial shade. The star jasmine needs regular watering. Leaves are dark green, oval, thick, about 2" long. This is a great plant on a trellis, in containers or in a parking strip. Another name: Maile Haole

Variegated Tasmanian Flax Lily

A grass-like plant with strap leaf foliage to 30" tall and even wider, this perennial has finely serrated margins with variegated white streaks. This flax lily has deep blue flowers that bloom in spring, followed by dark, metallic blue berries in summer. It will grow well and perhaps become invasive in coastal areas with full sun. However, it will do well in dry shade where it is less likely to become a problem. It looks great in containers.

Agave 'Blue Flame'

Blue Flame Agave

Blue Flame Agave is a handsome succulent that forms clumps with rosettes which individually are 2 feet tall by to 4 feet wide. Clumps can build up to 5 feet and taller. The rubbery blue-green leaves have finely serrate margins and terminal spine. The blue tink in the leaves come from a glaucous waxy cuticle that covers the surface of the younger leaves. This feature is sustained by new growth and by giving regular irrigation and avoiding overhead water that can wash the leaf off the leaf surface. Blue Flame should be planted in full sun except in hot inland and desert gardens where light shade will prevent scorching of the foliage.
